On 12 August (Thursday) at 11:00 a.m. a webinar will be held on the topic “Cultivation of strawberries under high mountain conditions – methods of cultivation and possibilities for minimizing agrotechnical operations”

During the online seminar Assoc. Prof. Emiliyan Popescu, PhD, from the Scientific Centre for Animal Husbandry and Agriculture – Smolyan will acquaint farmers with the main methods of cultivating strawberry plantations under high mountain conditions. Participants will have the opportunity to watch a pre-recorded video through which they will learn about ways to increase yields and reduce costs under adverse climatic conditions and the

possibilities for minimizing agrotechnical operations. - Minimizing the number of agrotechnical operations in strawberries through the use of herbicides and manual treatments;
