

Until May 29, applications for direct payments can be submitted without sanctions

The Ministry of Agriculture and Food, following consultations with the country's industry organizations and a green light from the European Commission, has extended the deadline for submitting applications for the 2015 Campaign until **May 29** without penalties.

The decision of the MAF affects all schemes for direct payments and transitional national aid, as well as the measures under the Rural Development Programs (RDP 2007-2013 and RDP 2014-2020), for which applications are made with the single aid application submitted according to the procedure of Ordinance No. 5 of February 27, 2009. The deadlines for making revisions to already submitted applications are also extended, including the addition of schemes, measures, parcels, or animals, which can be done until **June 15, 2015**. After May 29 until June 23 inclusive, farmers can submit applications, but with a penalty of 1% for each overdue working day.
