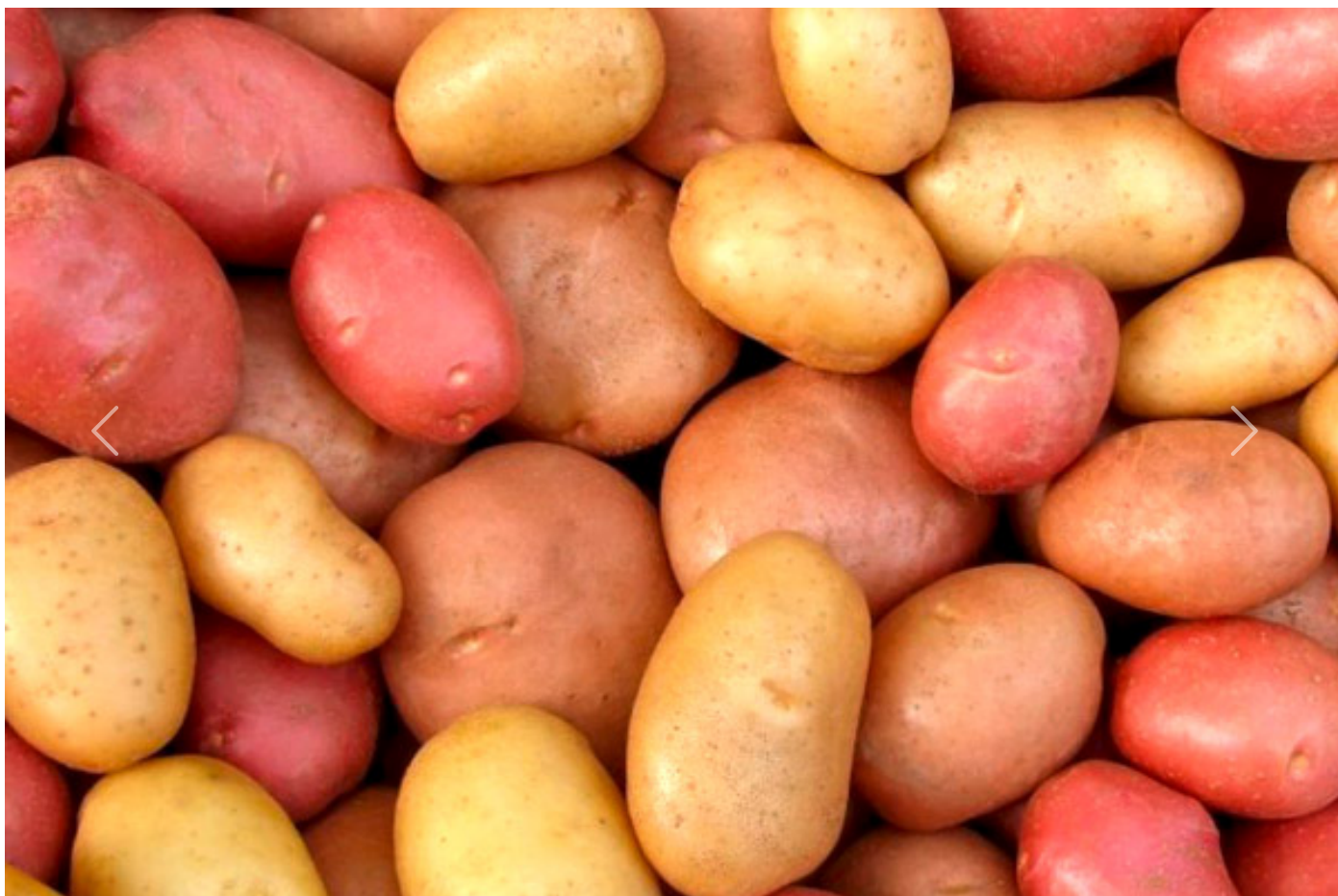


Potato varieties

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Bulgarian varieties

Ivertse, Nadezhda 25 (resistant to viral, fungal and mycoplasma diseases), Rozhen (moderately resistant to viral diseases, highly resistant to late blight on foliage and tubers and very highly resistant to scab and Rhizoctonia), Perun (high field resistance to viral diseases, late blight on tubers and scab, the first Bulgarian potato variety resistant to potato cyst nematode), Orpheus (field resistance to viral diseases and late blight on tubers, the first Bulgarian variety resistant to both root cyst nematodes *G. rostochiensis* and *G. pallida*).

Foreign varieties

Tresor (resistant to nematode, virus Y, scab and moderately resistant to late blight on tubers); Impala (resistant to late blight, Y virus disease and scab); Armada (resistant to nematode, late blight and leaf roll); Artemis (resistant to nematode, virus U and late blight on tubers, moderately resistant to leaf roll and scab); Adora (resistant to nematode and viruses X and A); Riviera (resistant to nematode, virus Y and scab); Carlita (resistant

to nematode, scab and late blight, susceptible to potato leaf roll virus and virus Y); Bonus (resistant to scab, late blight on tubers and wart disease); Amandine (resistant to scab and wart, moderately resistant to late blight, susceptible to virus Y and leaf roll); Latona (resistant to cyst nematode, scab and late blight on tubers); Vera (resistant to potato wart, common scab, viral diseases); Marine (immune to potato wart, resistant to nematode and scab, susceptible to virus Y and late blight); Safrane (resistant to wart and late blight on tubers, susceptible to late blight on foliage and virus Y); Nora (resistant to wart, late blight, Rhizoctonia and viruses M, X and leaf roll); Pyrol (resistant to nematode, wart and Rhizoctonia, moderately susceptible to virus Y and leaf roll virus); Arinda (resistant to Y virus disease, leaf roll, scab and Phytophthora); Amorosa (resistant to wart, nematode, virus Y and late blight); Sante (resistant to viruses X, Y, A, Phytophthora and nematode); Caesar (immune to potato wart, resistant to nematode, leaf roll and virus Y); Maestro (resistant to wart and nematode); Gilly (resistant to viruses X, Y, leaf roll, scab, Alternaria and nematode); Agria (resistant to nematode, viruses X, Y, A); Condor (immune to virus A and wart, good resistance to viruses X, Y, leaf roll, and moderate resistance to late blight on foliage and tubers).
