New label extensions will also be added:

- Rancona i-Mix (*ipconazole 20 g/l + imazalil 50 g/l*)
- Select Super 120 EC / Centurion Super (*clethodim 120 g/l*)
- Proplant 722 SL (*propamocarb 722 g/l*)
